Instruction

Proverbs 1:7 The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of knowledge: *but* fools despise wisdom and **instruction**.

Psalms 50:17 Seeing thou hatest **instruction**, and castest my words behind thee.

Deuteronomy 6:5 And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.

6 And these words, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart: **7** And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up.

8 And thou shalt bind them for a sign upon thine hand, and they shall be as frontlets between thine eyes.

9 And thou shalt write them upon the posts of thy house, and on thy gates.

Proverbs 1:2 To know wisdom and **instruction**; to perceive the words of understanding;

Proverbs 1:3 To receive the **instruction** of wisdom, justice, and judgment, and equity;

Proverbs 1:7 The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of knowledge: *but* fools despise wisdom and **instruction**.

8 My son, hear the **instruction** of thy father, and forsake not the law of thy mother:

Proverbs 4:1 Hear, ye children, the **instruction** of a father, and attend to know understanding.

Proverbs 4:13 Take fast hold of **instruction**; let *her* not go: keep her; for she *is* thy life.

Proverbs 5:12 And say, How have I hated **instruction**, and my heart despised reproof;

Proverbs 5:23 He shall die without **instruction**; and in the greatness of his folly he shall go astray.

Proverbs 6:23 For the commandment *is* a lamp; and the law *is* light; and reproofs of **instruction** *are* the way of life:

Proverbs 8:10 Receive my **instruction**, and not silver; and knowledge rather than choice gold.

Proverbs 8:33 Hear **instruction**, and be wise, and refuse it not.

Proverbs 9:9 Give **instruction** to a wise *man*, and he will be yet wiser: teach a just *man*, and he will increase in learning.

Proverbs 10:17 He *is in* the way of life that keepeth **instruction**: but he that refuseth reproof erreth.

Proverbs 12:1 Whoso loveth **instruction** loveth knowledge: but he that hateth reproof *is* brutish.

Proverbs 13:1 A wise son *heareth* his father's **instruction**: but a scorner heareth not rebuke.

Proverbs 13:18 Poverty and shame *shall be to* him that refuseth **instruction**: but he that regardeth reproof shall be honoured.

Proverbs 15:5 A fool despiseth his father's **instruction**: but he that regardeth reproof is prudent.

Proverbs 15:32 He that refuseth **instruction** despiseth his own soul: but he that heareth reproof getteth understanding.

33 The fear of the LORD *is* the **instruction** of wisdom; and before honour *is* humility.

Proverbs 16:22 Understanding *is* a wellspring of life unto him that hath it: but the **instruction** of fools *is* folly.

Proverbs 19:20 Hear counsel, and receive **instruction**, that thou mayest be wise in thy latter end.

Proverbs 19:27 Cease, my son, to hear the **instruction** *that causeth* to err from the words of knowledge.

Proverbs 23:12 Apply thine heart unto **instruction**, and thine ears to the words of knowledge.

Proverbs 23:23 Buy the truth, and sell *it* not; *also* wisdom, and **instruction**, and understanding.

Proverbs 24:32 Then I saw, *and* considered *it* well: I looked upon *it*, *and* received **instruction**.

Will Not Receive Instruction

Jeremiah 17:23 But they obeyed not, neither inclined their ear, but made their neck stiff, that they might not hear, nor receive **instruction**.

Jeremiah 32:33 And they have turned unto me the back, and not the face: though I taught them, rising up early and teaching *them*, yet they have not hearkened to receive **instruction**.

Jeremiah 35:13 Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Go and tell the men of Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem, Will ye not receive **instruction** to hearken to my words? saith the LORD.

2 Timothy 3:16 All scripture *is* given by inspiration of God, and *is* profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for **instruction** in righteousness:

We must study to show ourselves approved and a workman that needeth not to be ashamed. Then, after we understand The Word Of God we then are to instruct our children and others. How can we show anyone that which we ourselves do not understand?
