“...delivered us from the wrath to come.”

1 Th 1:10 And to wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead, even Jesus, which delivered us from the wrath to come.

“...God hath not appointed us to wrath...”

1 Th 5:9 For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ,

“...who hath warned you to flee from the wrath to come?”

Mat 3:7 But when he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees come to his baptism, he said unto them, O generation of vipers, who hath warned you to flee from the wrath to come?

“...who hath warned you to flee from the wrath to come?”

Luke 3:7 Then said he to the multitude that came forth to be baptized of him, O generation of vipers, who hath warned you to flee from the wrath to come?

Please note that in the 4 verses listed above that “The New Strong’s Exhaustive Concordance of the Bible” shows the same Greek word for wrath. It shows four different Greek words translated in the New Testament for the English word Wrath, but all the above come from the same word. The above leads me to feel that the final judgment, Hell or The Lake Of Fire is being referred to in these verses. Certainly this could not have been referring to the great tribulation when speaking to the Pharisees or the Sadducees.

## WRATH REFERRED TO IN REVELATION

"...O Lord God Almighty..."

"...thy wrath is come..." (v18)

Rev 11:17 Saying, We give thee thanks, O Lord God Almighty, which art, and wast, and art to come; because thou hast taken to thee thy great power, and hast reigned.

Rev 11:18 And the nations were angry, and thy wrath is come, and the time of the dead, that they should be judged, and that thou shouldest give reward unto thy servants the prophets, and to the saints, and them that fear thy name, small and great; and shouldest destroy them which destroy the earth.

"...wrath of God..."

Rev 14:10 The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb:

Rev 14:19 And the angel thrust in his sickle into the earth, and gathered the vine of the earth, and cast it into the great winepress of the wrath of God.

"...fierceness of his wrath..."

Rev 16:19 And the great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell: and great Babylon came in remembrance before God, to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his wrath.

"...wrath of Almighty God..."

Rev 19:15 And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

## WRATH OF THE LAMB

"...wrath of the Lamb..."

Rev 6:16 And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb:

### OPINION

Wrath of God- The plagues in Egypt were not on the children of Israel with them there. I have found the wrath of God in the book of Revelation only once before all kingdoms are given to Christ in Rev. 11:15. In Rev. 6:17 it is speaking of the great day. Note all others are after Rev. 11:15 as follows: Rev. 11:18, 14:10, 19, 15:1, 7, 16:1, 19, 19:15. Rev. 11:15 is when all kingdoms are given to Christ after the seventh angel sounded.

Wrath of God. Many say we will not go into the great tribulation period because we will not be subjected to the wrath of God. I agree we will not be under the wrath of God, however the children were in Egypt during the plagues but look where God's wrath went around them. They were allowed to put blood on the door post so their young would not die. It was no problem for God then, now or later. Much of the mentioning of the wrath of God is during the seven last plagues, seven vials and later.

# WRATH

### EXAMPLE:

## ABORTION

Jer. 1:5, "Before I formed thee in the belly I knew thee: and before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee, and I ordained thee a prophet unto the nations."

Ps. 139:13, "For thou hast possessed my reins: thou hast covered me in my mothers womb."

Is. 49:1, "Listen, O Isles, unto me; and hearken, ye people, from far; The Lord hath called me from the womb; from the bowels of my mother hath he made mention of my name."

Is. 49:5, "And now, saith the Lord that formed me from the womb to be his servant,---."

Is. 44:2, "Thus saith the Lord that that made thee, and formed thee from the womb, which will help thee;---."

To those who would question when life begins, the scripture has reference of several cases where the individual is referred to or even chosen before their birth. To me, there is nothing to debate, if you believe the Bible.

Malthus' thesis states that the population is increasing and the substance produced on the earth are not in proportion with the increase in population. In other words, as the population increases, the amount of substance to sustain life per person will decrease. Eventually, unchecked, we will starve ourselves to death from increased population.

The humanist feel so strongly about the over-population of the earth that they did have a special section in their publication dedicated to population to keep you updated every other month. Now they have a smaller section giving the names and addresses of seven organizations you can contact on the population crisis, including Zero Population Growth.

World wide 22% of the 210 million pregnancies end in abortion each year or 46 million. Hitler was estimated to have killed 6 million Jews. We kill 6 million by abortion every six weeks. In America our figures are 1.3 million per year abortions. It would take us 4 to 5 years to equal the 6 million mentioned

above. In America it seems we are killing at a speed close to Hitler's elimination of the Jews. Thirty-three percent of our births are from unwed mothers.

Free or low cost contraceptives services for poor woman and teenagers through publicly supported clinics are available in fifty states. Thirty-seven percent of the teenagers (sexually active) as Planned Parenthood would refer to them are in Need in Arkansas, ranks fifty-one percent.

The figures are staggering or mind boggling. It is my understanding we have already killed approximately forty seven million here in America as of 2005 (currently I would estimate between 48 and 50 million). How can this be tolerated by Christians? Atheistic doctrine flows freely through our veins.

## **Those killed are silent, have no voice, and in most cases we fail to speak for them.**

Yes, the educated ones have reasoned and put intellectual contemplation to work feeling it is simple, like a farmer thinning corn. We decide who will live and who will die. Mans reasoning is the highest appeal these babies will get.

When the time comes to stand before the master would you prefer to be a Nazi storm trooper or an unregistered voter that did not want to go to the polls and vote, much less voting a Biblical based vote?

We kill babies but if one slipped through and lives we would fine the mother for not protecting its life in a restraint in a car.
