We do not find the word Trinity in the Bible. The philosophy of the Father, Son and Holy Ghost or Spirit is self evident in the scriptures. The word Trinity could suggest to some that the three are equal but we do not find this to be the case. See the scriptures to follow and see what you think. We cannot find the word Trinity appearing until around 200-300 A. D. If you find differently let us know.

Though the idea existed prior to that time Oneness seems to have started in this country somewhere around 1914. Also note the denominations that it is prevalent in had not been started too far in advance to that. I see no supporting scriptures to support this idea. There are numerous scriptures supporting that all three, Father, Son and Holy Spirit or Holy Ghost are mentioned. There are several scriptures used that some say supports a Oneness theory but if you take the

entire Bible precept upon precept or the whole council of God (His Word – Bible) then they are quickly ruled out.
