### Prayer 6

#### **Jesus Speaking to the Father before His Arrest, Trial and Crucifixion**

**John 17:1** These words spake Jesus, and lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, **Father**, the hour is come; glorify thy Son, that thy Son also may glorify thee:

**2** As thou hast **given him** power over all flesh, that he should give eternal life to as many as thou hast **given him**.

**3** And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent.

**4** I have glorified thee on the earth: I have finished the work which thou **gavest me** to do.

**5** And now, O **Father**, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was.

**6** I have manifested thy name unto the men which thou **gavest me** out of the world: thine they were, and thou **gavest them me**; and they have kept thy word.

**7** Now they have known that all things whatsoever thou hast **given me** are of thee.

**8** For I have given unto them the words which thou **gavest me**; and they have received *them*, and have known surely that I came out from thee, and they have believed that thou didst send me.

**9** I pray for them: I pray not for the world, but for them which thou hast **given me**; for they are thine.

**10** And all mine are thine, and thine are mine; and I am glorified in them.

**11** And now I am no more in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to thee. **Holy Father**, keep through thine own name those whom thou hast **given me**, that they may be one, as we are.

**12** While I was with them in the world, I kept them in thy name: those that **thou gavest me** I have kept, and none of them is lost, but the son of perdition; that the scripture might be fulfilled.

**13** And now come I to thee; and these things I speak in the world, that they might have my joy fulfilled in themselves.

**14** I have given them thy word; and the world hath hated them, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world.

**15** I pray not that thou shouldest take them out of the world, but that thou shouldest keep them from the evil.

**16** They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world.

**17** Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.

**18** As thou hast sent me into the world, even so have I also sent them into the world.

**19** And for their sakes I sanctify myself, that they also might be sanctified through the truth.

**20** Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word;

**21** That they all may be one; as thou, Father, *art* in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me.

**22** And the glory which thou **gavest me** I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one:

**23** I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me.

**24 Father**, I will that they also, whom thou hast **given me**, be with me where I am; that they may behold my glory, which thou hast given me: for thou lovedst me before the foundation of the world.

**25** O righteous **Father**, the world hath not known thee: but I have known thee, and these have known that thou hast sent me.

**26** And I have declared unto them thy name, and will declare *it*: that the love wherewith thou hast loved me may be in them, and I in them.

**John 18:1** When Jesus had spoken these words, he went forth with his disciples over the brook Cedron, where was a garden, into the which he entered, and his disciples.

Please note in the next verse in the next chapter after the prayer of Christ he and his disciples went forth over the brook Cedron, where was a garden, into which he entered, and his disciples. I have thought for years that the prayer in John Chapter 17 was in the garden of Gethsemane, but it was before he entered the garden as you see in verse 1 of John Chapter 18.

## **Alms Not to Be Seen of Men - Do in Secret**

**Matthew 6:1** Take heed that ye do not your alms before men, to be seen of them: otherwise ye have no reward of your Father which is in heaven.

**2** Therefore when thou doest *thine* alms, do not sound a trumpet before thee, as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and in the streets, that they may have glory of men. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward.

**3** But when thou doest alms, let not thy left hand know what thy right hand doeth:

**4** That thine alms may be in secret: and thy Father which seeth in secret himself shall reward thee openly.

## **Pray Not to Be Seen of Men**

**Matthew 6:5** And when thou prayest, thou shalt not be as the hypocrites *are*: for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and in the corners of the streets, that they may be seen of men. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward.

**6** But thou, when thou prayest, enter into thy closet, and when thou hast shut thy door, pray to thy Father which is in secret; and thy Father which seeth in secret shall reward thee openly.

**7** But when ye pray, use not vain repetitions, as the heathen *do*: for they think that they shall be heard for their much speaking.

**8** Be not ye therefore like unto them: for your Father knoweth what things ye have need of, before ye ask him.

## Pray in this Manner

**Matthew 6:9** After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.

**10** Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as *it is* in heaven.

**11** Give us this day our daily bread.

**12** And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.

**13** And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen.

**2 Chronicles 12:14** And he did evil, because he prepared not his heart to seek the LORD.

**Matthew 6:24** No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.

**25** Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life, what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink; nor yet for your body, what ye shall put on. Is not the life more than meat, and the body than raiment?

**26** Behold the fowls of the air: for they sow not, neither do they reap, nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feedeth them. Are ye not much better than they?

**27** Which of you by taking thought can add one cubit unto his stature?

**28** And why take ye thought for raiment? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they toil not, neither do they spin:

**29** And yet I say unto you, That even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these.

**30** Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which to day is, and to morrow is cast into the oven, *shall he* not much more *clothe* you, O ye of little faith?

**Luke 23:34** Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted his raiment, and cast lots.

Even facing death Christ was asking the Father to forgive them for they did not know what they were doing. They were committing one of the gravest sins by killing the innocent Son of God who had come to save those that were lost.

We should be willing to pray with our last breath for those that despitely use us and persecute us.
