“Thou shalt plant vineyards , ...” (verse 39)

“...and dress them, but shalt neither drink of the wine, ...” (verse 39)

“...nor gather the grapes; ...” (verse 39)

“... for the worms shall eat them.” (verse 39)

Deuteronomy chapter 28 gives us the blessings and the curses. The blessings are given in verses 1 through 14. These verses are for us if we observe and do all the commandments that are given to us. Verses 15 through 68 are the curses if we go aside from any of the words. As you can see the above curses are only through verse 39 so this is only a particle list.

Deuteronomy 28:1 And it shall come to pass, if thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe *and* to do all his commandments which I command thee this day, that the LORD thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the earth:

Deuteronomy 28:15 But it shall come to pass, if thou wilt not hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe to do all his commandments and his statutes which I command thee this day; that all these curses shall come upon thee, and overtake thee:

Galatians 3:29 "And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise."
