HAVE YOU COME ONE ON ONE WITH THE LORD?

INFALLIBLE WORD

DEFINITION: INFALLIBLE- "...INCAPABLE OF ERROR IN DEFINING DOCTRINE TOUCHING FAITH OR MORALS ..." (Webster's New Collegiate Dictionary second edition)

WE STAGGER AT THE PROMISE

Rom 4:20 **He staggered not** at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God;

Rom 4:21 And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform.

Abraham did not stagger at the promise that God had made to him in that he would raise up nations through him through the child of promise, Issac. Abraham was told to offer him as a sacrifice and Abraham did not stagger. He knew God could and would keep his promise even if Issac was offered as a sacrifice. God could raise him from the dead if necessary to fulfill His promise.

WE STAGGER AT GOD'S WORD EVEN THOUGH HE SAYS HIS WORD WILL STAND FOREVER AND IT IS PURE AND HAS BEEN TRIED IN THE FIRE SEVEN TIMES.

The critics often challenge the King James Version of the Bible, the translators, etc., etc. etc., but I still ask you **DO WE STAGGER AT GOD'S PROMISE OR NOT?**

WORD OF GOD

"Word of God" appears 49 times in 48 verses in the bible. It appears 44 times in the New Testament with 7 times in the 4 gospels (Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John).

Heb 4:12 For the **word of God** is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

2 Tim 3:16 All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for

correction, for instruction in righteousness:

BRING ALL THINGS TO YOUR REMEMBRANCE

John 14:26 But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

John 16:4 But these things have I told you, that when the time shall come, ye may remember that I told you of them. And these things I said not unto you at the beginning, because I was with you.

DO YOU BELIEVE GOD CAN KEEP WHAT HE HAS PROMISED?

EVERY WORD OF GOD IS PURE

Prov 30:5 **Every word of God is pure:** he is a shield unto them that put their trust in him.

Prov 30:6 **Add thou not unto his words,** lest he reprove thee, and thou be found a liar.

Psa 12:6 The **words of the LORD are pure words:** as silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified seven times.

Psa 18:30 As for God, **his way is perfect:** the word of the LORD is tried: he is a buckler to all those that trust in him.

Psa 19:8 The statutes of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart: **the commandment of the LORD is pure,** enlightening the eyes.

Isa 40:8 The grass withereth, the flower fadeth: but the word of our God shall **stand for ever.**

1 Pet 1:25 But the word of the Lord **endureth for ever.** And this is the word which by the gospel is preached unto you.

2 Pet 1:20 Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation.

2 Pet 1:21 For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but **holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost.**

Acts 1:3 To whom also he showed himself alive after his passion by many **infallible proofs,** being seen of them forty days, and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God:

CHRIST IS THE WORD

John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

John 1:2 The same was in the beginning with God.

John 1:3 All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made.

John 1:4 In him was life; and the life was the light of men.

John 1:5 And the light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended

CHRIST DID NOT CHANGE THE WORD BUT FULFILLED THE WORD

The word **fulfilled** is in the New Testament 57 times. It is used 16 times in the gospel of Matthew. Most all are referring to the scriptures being fulfilled by Christ coming.

Mat 1:22 Now all this was done, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet, saying,

Mat 5:17 Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil.

See also in Matthew alone: Mat, 2:15, 17, 23, 4:14, 5:18, 8:17, 12:17, 13:14, 35, 21:4, 24:34, 26:54, 56, 27:9

Our modern day critics feel that every word of the Bible is subject to be questioned as to translation and what manuscript it came from. All judgment is given unto Christ, yet he never questioned the scripture nor did he change the wording, not one word. Christ fulfilled the Word.

CHRIST IS THE JUDGE

John 5:22 For the Father judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son:

John 5:23 That all men should honour the Son, even as they honour the Father. He that honoureth not the Son honoureth not the Father which hath sent him.

John 5:24 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life.

CHRIST OFTEN REFERRED TO THE SCRIPTURE OR SCRIPTURES

SOME EXAMPLES IN THE FOUR GOSPELS

SCRIPTURE: Mk.12:10, Lk. 4:21, John 7:38, 10:35, 13:18, 17:12,

SCRIPTURES: Mt. 21:42, 22:29, 26:54, 26:56, Mk.12:24,14:49, John. 5:39

CHRIST DID NOT CRITICIZE THE SCRIPTURES

I do not find where Christ ever questioned, criticized or changed any scripture. At the time of Christ he would be referring to the Old Testament as the New Testament had not yet been written. Our modern critics change the Old Testament as well as the New Testament. Let us remember all judgment is given into his hands. (John 5:22-24)

IT IS WRITTEN

Mat 26:24 The Son of man goeth **as it is written** of him: but woe unto that man by whom the Son of man is betrayed! it had been good for that man if he had not been born.

Also look up: Mark 1:2 Mark 7:6 Mark 9:13 Mark 14:21 Luke 2:23 Luke 3:4 John 6:31 John 12:14

It appears clear to me that we are to take the scriptures as they are written, not to change, question or correct as we deem necessary. "IT IS WRITTEN" appears 80 in the Bible of which 63 are in the N.T.

CHRIST KEPT THE WORD

Often Christ was challenged about the law but I do not find where Christ ever broke the law. He kept the scriptures and the commandments of God.

ONE JOT OR ONE TITTLE

Mat 5:18 For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass

from the law, till all be fulfilled.

Mark 7:9 And he said unto them, Full well ye reject the commandment of God, that ye may keep your own tradition.

Mark 10:19 Thou knowest the commandments, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Defraud not, Honour thy father and mother.

Mark 12:24 And Jesus answering said unto them, Do ye not therefore err, because ye know not the scriptures, neither the power of God?

Luke 16:29 Abraham saith unto him, They have Moses and the prophets; let them hear them.

Luke 16:30 And he said, Nay, father Abraham: but if one went unto them from the dead, they will repent.

Luke 16:31 And he said unto him, If they hear not Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded, though one rose from the dead.

Mark 7:6 He answered and said unto them, Well hath Esaias prophesied of you hypocrites, as it is written, This people honoureth me with their lips, but their heart is far from me.

Mark 7:10 For Moses said, Honour thy father and thy mother; and, Whoso curseth father or mother, let him die the death:

Acts 1:3 To whom also he showed himself alive after his passion by many infallible proofs, being seen of them forty days, and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God:

John 12:48 He that rejecteth me, and receiveth not my words, hath one that judgeth him: the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day.

Rom 2:16 In the day when God shall judge the secrets of men by Jesus Christ according to my gospel.

ABSOLUTES:

Rom 3:4 God forbid: yea, let God be true, but every man a liar; as it is written, That thou mightest be justified in thy sayings, and mightest overcome when thou art judged.

A few decades ago many people were saying there are no absolutes. The humanist are critics and question everything thinking if it is true it will stand the test. God's Word is true and has been tried seven times in the fire. It is an absolute and can not be changed. It will stand forever.

CONCLUSION: GOD'S WORD IS INFALLIBLE AND IS WITHOUT ERROR AND IS NOT TO BE CHANGED OR CORRECTED BUT KEPT. DO WE STAGGER AT GOD'S PROMISE TO KEEP HIS WORD? (Not man but GOD)
