(About The Sabbath)

IN THE BEGINNING

Genesis 1:

1 In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

Genesis 2:

1 Thus the heavens and the earth were finished, and all the host of them.

2 And on the seventh day God ended his work which he had made; and he rested on the seventh day from all his work which he had made.

3 And God blessed the seventh day, and sanctified it: because that in it he had rested from all his work which God created and made.

John 1:

1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

2 The same was in the beginning with God.

3 All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made.

SEETH THE FATHER DO

John 5:19 Then answered Jesus and said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do: for what things soever he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise.

Can anyone question that Christ was here from the beginning and certainly saw God rest on the seventh day? In John 5:19 he says ...“what he seeth the Father do: for what things soever he doeth, these also

doeth the Son likewise.”

FATHER TAUGHT HIM

John 8:28 Then said Jesus unto them, When ye have lifted up the Son of man, then shall ye know that I am he, and that I do nothing of myself; but as my Father hath taught me, I speak these things.

29 And he that sent me is with me: the Father hath not left me alone; for I do always those things that please him.

John 5:20 For the Father loveth the Son, and sheweth him all things that himself doeth: and he will shew him greater works than these, that ye may marvel.

KEPT THE FATHER'S COMMANDMENTS

John 15:10 If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love.

Exodus 20:8 Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy.

Christ said follow him and that he kept his Father's commandments. Can we question the Sabbath as one of the commandments? Show us in the Bible where it has been changed or rescinded.

1. The seventh day was made before sin entered the world. (Gen. 2:3)
2. The seventh day was made by God.(Gen. 2:2)
3. God rested on the seventh day. (Gen. 2:2)
4. The seventh day was blessed and sanctified before sacrifices were instituted. (Gen. 2:3)
5. God gave us a day of rest. (Ex. 31:17)
6. Heb 4:8 **For if Jesus had given them rest, then would he not afterward have spoken of another day.**
7. Scriptures were given for the change in circumcision (Rom. 2:29), and sacrifice from animals to the blood of Christ. (Heb. 10:12) No scripture is given to change the Sabbath to another day.
8. The Sabbath was written in the law by the finger of God. (Ex. 31:18)
9. Christ kept the Father's commandments. (John 15:10)
10. **Col 2:16 Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the new moon, or of the sabbath days:**
11. We should all love God and want to keep His commandments and share in the promised blessings.

Mark 2:27 And he said unto them, The sabbath was made for man, and not man for the sabbath:

Note: not made for the Jew, Israelite, or Hebrew, but man. The seventh day of rest was started before sin entered the world (blessed and sanctified).

Mark 2:28 Therefore the Son of man is Lord also of the sabbath.

John 15:10 If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I

have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love.

Christ kept the Father's commandments. I hardly see how you can exclude the 10 commandments written by the finger of the Father, if not then the sabbath is one of the ten.

Mal 3:6 For I am the LORD, I change not; therefore ye sons of Jacob are not consumed.

Isa. 58:13 ¶If thou turn away thy foot from the sabbath, from doing thy pleasure on my holy day; and call the sabbath a delight, the holy of the LORD, honourable; and shalt honour him, not doing thine own ways, nor finding thine own pleasure, nor speaking thine own words:

REGARDLESS YOUR POSITION ON THE MATTER WOULD WE NOT BE BLESSED IF WE KEEP THE DAY GOD HIMSELF SET UP AND GAVE US THE EXAMPLE OR ANY COMMANDMENT, LAW OR PROMISE THAT GOD HAS GIVEN US?

Mal 3:10 Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it.

Mal 3:11 And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, and he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground; neither shall your vine cast her fruit before the time in the field, saith the LORD of hosts.

Mal 3:12 And all nations shall call you blessed: for ye shall be a delightsome land, saith the LORD of hosts.

BLESSINGS

Deu 28:1 And it shall come to pass, if thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe and to do all his commandments which I command thee this day, that the LORD thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the earth:

CURSES

Deu 28:15 But it shall come to pass, if thou wilt not hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe to do all his commandments and his statutes which I command thee this day; that all these curses shall come upon thee, and overtake thee:

SABBATH

The traditionally accepted way is thought by most not to have to be proven because everyone believes or accepts it anyway. We accept Sunday basically because it is traditionally accepted and needs no proof. RIGHT OR WRONG IT IS ACCEPTED. I once heard a preacher say why argue or debate between Saturday and Sunday since our generation keeps neither.

The sabbath is mentioned numerous times in the 1,000 year reign.

It appears to me that God gave mankind a Standard in the beginning of the seventh day by blessing and sanctifying it as well as keeping it. When the law came he wrote it as a commandment, and a law writing it by his own finger in stone and made a covenant with Israel. Now we that are born again children of God are children of Israel by adoption. The blessings will fall to us as surely as Joseph's two

adopted sons received a greater portion.

Matthew 12:

8 For the Son of man is Lord even of the sabbath day.

Mark 2:

27 And he said unto them, The sabbath was made for man, and not man for the sabbath:

28 Therefore the Son of man is Lord also of the sabbath.

Luke 6:

5 And he said unto them, That the Son of man is Lord also of the sabbath.

Note: The Sabbath was made for man and not man for the Sabbath. It did not say for the Jew, the Hebrew, the Israelites, for Israel, the sons of Jacob, nor for Abraham's descendants, but for man.

The previously mentioned scriptures make it clear: 1. The Father taught the Son. 2. The Son did what He saw the Father do. 3. The Son did nothing of himself. 4. The Son kept the commandments of God. The Sabbath is one of the commandments. I really do not see why there is any question.
