**2** (For the life was manifested, and we have seen it, and bear witness, and shew unto you that eternal life, which was with the Father, and was manifested unto us;)

**3** That which we have seen and heard declare we unto you, that ye also may have **fellowship** with us: and truly our fellowship is with the Father, and with his Son Jesus Christ.

**1 Corn. 12: 12** For as the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also is Christ.

**13** For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.

**Eph. 4: 1** I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you that ye walk worthy of the vocation wherewith ye are called,

**2** With all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love;

**4** There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling;

**5** One Lord, one faith, one baptism,

**35** By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another.

**Gal. 5:13** For, brethren, ye have been called unto liberty; only use not liberty for an occasion to the flesh, but by love serve one another.

**14** For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this; Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

**15** But if ye bite and devour one another, take heed that ye be not consumed one of another.

**1 John 1:3** That which we have seen and heard declare we unto you, that ye also may have **fellowship** with us: and truly our fellowship is with the Father, and with his Son Jesus Christ.

**4** And these things write we unto you, that your joy may be full.

**5** This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all.

**6** If we say that we have fellowship with him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth:

**7** But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have **fellowship** one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.

**Gal. 2:9 Eph. 3:9 Phil 1:5**

**Gal. 2:9** And when James, Cephas, and John, who seemed to be pillars, perceived the grace that was given unto me, they gave to me and Barnabas the **right hands of fellowship**; that we should go unto the heathen, and they unto the circumcision.

**Eph. 3:9** And to make all men see what is the **fellowship of the mystery**, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, who created all things by Jesus Christ: (see Eph. 5:11)

**Phil 1:5** For your **fellowship in the gospel** from the first day until now; (see Phil. 2:1, 3:10)

**1 Cor. 1:9** God is faithful, by whom ye were called unto the **fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ** our Lord.

**1 Cor. 10:20** But I say, that the things which the Gentiles sacrifice, they sacrifice to devils, and not to God: and I would not that ye should have **fellowship** with devils.

**2 Cor. 6:14** Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness?

**2 Cor. 8:4** Praying us with much intreaty that we would receive the gift, and take upon us the **fellowship** of the ministering to the saints.

**Acts 2:42** And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers.
