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Let us look at what the atheist doctrine has to say about change. The following comes from The Humanist Manifesto I and II with No. I written in 1933 and signed by 34 people, one of which was John Dewey the father of the Modern Progressive Educational System. Pull up Humanist Manifesto I and II on your computer and read it for yourself and kindly e-mail me and let me know what part of it that the philosophy is not taught in our public school system. If it is not there it is being worked on.

WHAT DOES THE HUMANIST MANIFESTO I SAY?

"The time has come for widespread recognition of the radical changes in religious beliefs throughout the modern world. The time is past for mere revision of traditional attitudes... While this age does owe a vast debt to traditional religions, it is none the less obvious that any religion that can hope to be a synthesizing and dynamic force for today must be shaped for the needs of this age..." (Manifesto I: Introduction)

"...The distinction between the sacred and the secular can no longer be maintained." (Section Seventh)

What does the Humanist Manifesto II say?

"We reject all religious ideological, or moral codes that denigrate the individual, suppress freedom, dull intellect, dehumanize personality. We believe in maximum individual autonomy consonant with social responsibility. . ." (The Individual - fifth section)

"We affirm that moral values derive their source from human experience. . ." (Ethics-Third Section)

What does the Bible say?

"But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God." (Matthew 4:4)

The humanist believe there is no heaven to gain or a hell to shun, therefore they feel they are free. The Bible teaches the exact opposite to the Manifesto.

REASON

We have changed the God of our fathers (Father, Son, And Holy Spirit) for the god of Reason. By doing this we feel we have enabled ourselves to be free from the commandments of God and His Holy Word the Bible. We can do anything that we reason to be right. We now pick and choose what scriptures we want to believe. We can now interpret them anyway we wish to. We openly proclaim that each person has his/her right to interpret any way they see fit. Our great scholars of Reason have become our leaders of our nation. Our great scholars of Reason within our denominations have become our heroes. We bend and sway in the school of Reason. Truly this has become our god. We believe that the commands of God can be changed by Reason. We reason that ethics and morals are for the good of man. We decide what is good and what is bad, not God. We have moved slowly by reason from ethics to SITUATIONAL ETHICS. We now think we have the ability to decide right and wrong for an individual person, in a given state of circumstances, to determine if it is right for that person at that time, in this particular situation.

REASON has now become the greatest or highest appeal known to man. Let me give you an example. An unborn has no voice. We reason that the right of the mother is superior to the right of the child, even the father for that matter. The reason of the mother, the doctor, and even the courts will over shadow the rights of the child to live. If the reason is felt to be sound then kill the child. We have killed close to 50 million so far we are steam rolling right along. We seemingly look at it as if we are doing away with the unwanted and unneeded . It is like a farmer thinning corn or as the humanist would put it population control, or hoping for a zero population growth. Now each group of people can establish their own standards and simply call them VALUES. What God says does not enter the picture even in our higher courts.

We have changed the Bible into many versions were you can pick and choose the version and what it says. If you do not like what one version says then choose another. Since the modern day Christian

seemingly feels there are no absolutes he/she can pick and choose what bible and what scriptures they feel applies to them.

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ETHICS

Ethics - Moral, custom, a man's normal state

Moral - Relating to, dealing with, or capable of making the distinction between, right and wrong in conduct.

Value- to be strong, to be worth

As long as we have God and the Bible, why would we need a source other than it to tell us right and wrong. The Bible is very clear on what is sin and what is not.

When a group of people do not want to follow the Lord and His commandments, they must of necessity seek other rules to live by. We may do as the Humanist do in the Humanist Manifesto II written in 1973, refer to it as ethics. The old Greeks also looked to ethics. Years ago you seldom heard the word ethics used. Today it is used regularly. Value is used frequently.

To me the word value is to distinguish between what is acceptable, and what is not acceptable is offensive. Think for a minute when Christians say what is of value. Is man deciding what to accept or not to accept? God gave commandments for us to go by. We either do as He commanded or we sin. That is pretty simple. Different people will decide different things as to what is right and wrong.

Our laws now are guided by morals, ethics, and values and not the commandments of God.

Col.2:8, "Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ."

Ep. 5:6-7, "Let no man deceive you with vain words: for because of these things cometh the wrath of God upon the children of disobedience.

Be not ye therefore partakers with them."

One day, a number of years ago I had a private discussion with a man rather high in the social scale. He ran for office at one time. I really think it was for governor, but, he did not make it. When discussing the Lord and the Bible, he snapped back at me that he knew what I was trying to do, which was to advocate my particular persuasion. This has stuck with me for years. What it amounts to is (particularly in the political field) that we have all sorts of religions in our nation. To each his own and each has his own persuasion. Yes, I want to promote my own persuasion, the Bible.

Is. 5:20-21, "Woe unto them that call evil good, and good evil; that put darkness for light, and light for darkness; that put bitter for sweet, and sweet for bitter!

Woe unto them that are wise in their own eyes, and prudent in their own sight!"

Man is not capable of making his own rules, and he is continually changing them to fit the situation. However, our legislatures appear to feel that they are capable of doing so.

Is 9:16, "For the leaders of this people cause them to err: and they that are led of them are destroyed."

The Bible clearly states that we are to follow God and Him alone keeping His commandments not our own.

Mat.15:8-9, "This people draweth nigh unto me with their mouth, and honoureth me with their lips; but their heart is far from me.

But in vain they do worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men."

To simplify it, if there are no absolutes, we must make our own rules. In effect they are saying if there is no God there are no commandments. We therefore must set to the task of making our own. Our rules

will be situational and subject to change. Human experience will determine our values by our needs and interest. Isn't it amazing how mixed up things can get in such a short time? I recognize my ignorance and short comings. I wish someone out there would show me what part of The Humanist Manifesto I and

Manifesto II that our schools and government do not go by. It would be no problem to find what part of the Bible is not abided by.

One additional sentence not mentioned in the above quotation in the same paragraph is...“We strive for the good life here and now.”

Our values are to promote good. Values are man made and we place value on them, not God.
Commandments of God are for Christians to obey, without question and for the love of God.
