WILL WE GO INTO THE TRIBULATION PERIOD?

PART I

MATTHEW 24 AND RELATED SCRIPTURES

MIND SETS (Be careful of these mind sets)

Many Say:

1. Mt. Chp. 24 is for the Jews only not for the Christian. (Jews only go through the tribulation)
2. We will be taken up in the Rapture before the Tribulation Period and we will not be here.
3. Mt. 24:3-34 is not in Chronological order (In order of events).
4. The Holy Spirit is taken out and is not here during the Tribulation period.

1.

Would you be able to understand if your mind was already made up before you read on any of the above 4 points?. You then would probably not understand. In chapter 24 of Matthew Christ was ask by the disciples about his coming again. I would say at least 14 pronouns referring back to the disciples are in this chapter. The disciples were the starting of the church and were here after Christ was taken up. They were the ones asking. If this chapter was written to Jews why was it not given in the Old Testament? There is far more prophesy of end time in the Old Testament than the New Testament. To me it is as clear as a crystal Christ is showing us what is coming by telling his disciples.

The Rapture theory is a subject within itself. I find no viable evidence or one scripture that says we will be taken out before the Tribulation Period. This is discussed in details on our web site under the booklet Rapture www.endtimescriptures.com. All 3 (pre-mid-post tribulation theories) are discussed, but I see only the post as being biblically supported.

The critic can find what they might call supporting evidence that the 24th chapter of Matthew verses 3-34 are not in chronological order. An example is verse 13 and 14 stops and gives prophesy of what is to come “...shall endure unto the end...”and “...gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world...”. Note both of these use the word **shall** showing it is to come. Basically to verse 34 it is clear to me that the trend is chronological order. The abomination of desolation is spoken of in verse 15 (“...when ye shall therefore see the abomination of desolation...”). In verse 29 it is stated (“...immediately **after** the tribulation of those days...”) which gives a definite order of events.

Mark 13:11 But when they shall lead you, and deliver you up, take no thought beforehand what ye shall speak, neither do ye premeditate: but whatsoever shall be given you in that hour, that speak ye: for it is not ye that speak, but the Holy Ghost.

There are those that say the Holy Spirit or the Holy Ghost will be taken out during the tribulation period. The above is a scripture showing the Holy Ghost will be here. Most say there will be those saved during the tribulation period, but how could that be if the Holy Spirit is gone. Is conviction of our sins not by the Spirit? Does he not dwell in us when we are saved? How can one be saved without the Spirit?

Why would the days be shortened for the elect's sake if they are not here? Verse 22

How can we see the abomination of desolation if we are not here? Verse 15

How can we endure unto the end if we are not here? Verse 13

How are they going to deliver us up if we are not here? Verse 9

How are we going to be afflicted and killed if we are not here? Verse 9

How are we going to be hated of all nations if we are not here? Verse 9

How are we going to be offended if we are not here? Verse 10

Why are we warned of false prophets if we are not here? Verse 11

How can we be deceived if we are not here? Verses 4 – 5

How are we going to see all these things if we are not here? Verse 33
How are we going to watch if we are not here? Verse 42

Why has the Lord given us details after details if we are not here? Chapter 24

ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION:

What is the abomination of desolation? It is the period of time when the beast takes over the earth until Armageddon. This will be 1290 days. The beast will control the earth, all nations, kindred and tongues for 42 months or 1260 days. It starts when the daily sacrifice in the temple is taken away (Dan. 12:11). Satan's servant or servants will control the earth including Israel. It is a time like has never been before or ever shall be. Satan's servants control the earth, the beast and false prophet, during this period of time for 42 months or 1260 days. During the last 30 days the ten kings have power one hour with the beast. They turn their power over to the beast. This is when they gather their army to make war with the Lamb and He shall overcome them.

During the abomination of desolation Israel will be desolate. All of Israel but a remnant will be killed, die or sent into captivity. The scattered of Israel will return after Armageddon, which will be a remnant of all the tribes.

BEGINNING OF SORROW

Mat 24:8 All these are the beginning of sorrows.

“...Take heed that no man deceive you.” (Mt. 24:4)

“...wars and rumours of wars:...” (Mt. 24:6)

“...nation shall rise against nation,...” (Mt. 24:7)

“...and kingdom against kingdom:...” (Mt. 24:7)

“...there shall be famines,...” (Mt. 24:7)

“...pestilences,...” (Mt. 24:7.)

“...earthquakes, in divers places.” (Mt. 24:7)

“...beginning of sorrows.”

Mat 24:8 All these are the beginning of sorrows.

Jesus was ask by his disciples when shall these things be and what will be the sign. The first thing he mentioned was deception in verse 4 then he mentioned all the above. We have seen what he mentioned down to verse 8 in my generation. The wars are almost to numerous to mention. Nation has arisen against nation and kingdom against kingdom. In verse 8 he states that **all** these are the beginning of sorrow.

ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION

MATTHEW 24

In verse 15 of Mt.:24 it states “When ye therefore shall see the abomination spoken of by Daniel the prophet...”

In verse 29 of Mt. 24 it states “**Immediately after** the tribulation of those days...” (Mt. 24:29)

MARK 13

In verse 14 of Mark 13 it states “But when you see the abomination of desolation spoken of by Daniel the prophet...”

Mark 13:24 ¶But in those days, after **that** tribulation, the sun shall be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light,

25 And the stars of heaven shall fall, and the powers that are in heaven shall be shaken.

26 And then shall they see the Son of man coming in the clouds with great power and glory.

27 And then shall he send his angels, and shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from the uttermost part of the earth to the uttermost part of heaven.

Please note that from Mark 13:14 to Mark 13:24 it is depicting the abomination of desolation, then in verse 24 it states after that tribulation (which of necessity it must be speaking of the abomination), in verse 26 it states then shall they see the Son of man coming in the clouds.

How can it be understood any other way than that the Son of man is coming and gather his elect after **that** tribulation period when Satan's servants had control of the earth.

A lady once ask me how can anyone, minister or lay person interpret Matthew 24 other than the Lord is coming back toward the end of the tribulation period? She stated if you studied it verse by verse and word by word there was no other conclusion you could rationally come to.
