Forgive - Be Forgiven

**Matthew 7:1** Judge not, that ye be not judged.

**2** For with what judgment ye judge, ye shall be judged: and with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you again.

**Mt. 6:14** For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you:

**15** But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

The above two verses (Mt. 6:14-15) are on the beginning of each of the two newsletters for March and April 2020 on the subject of forgiveness. Please note it is clear if we do not forgive, the Father will not forgive us. If we really believed this surely we would try to teach and practice it. **Matthew 22:37** Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind.

**Mark 12:30** And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment.

**Luke 10:27** And he answering said, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbour as thyself.

***“... forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.”*** Mt. 6:12

**Mt. 6:11** After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.

**10** Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as *it is* in heaven.

**11** Give us this day our daily bread.

**12** And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.

**13** And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen.

I have seen and heard the Lords Prayer, or the model prayer that Christ gave the disciples in the sermon on the mount for years or most all my life, but I really never understood the fact that Christ told us to ask only for debts to be forgiven that we were willing to forgive others. The fact was further clarified in Mt. 6:15 it states if we do not forgive men their trespasses our heavenly Father will not forgive our trespasses.

**Matthew 18:21** Then came Peter to him, and said, Lord, how oft shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? till seven times?

**22** Jesus saith unto him, I say not unto thee, Until seven times: but, Until seventy times seven.

***“...if ye from your hearts forgive not...”*** Mt. 18:35

**Matthew 18:23** ¶Therefore is the kingdom of heaven likened unto a certain king, which would take account of his servants.

**24** And when he had begun to reckon, one was brought unto him, which owed him ten thousand talents.

**25** But forasmuch as he had not to pay, his lord commanded him to be sold, and his wife, and children, and all that he had, and payment to be made.

**26** The servant therefore fell down, and worshipped him, saying, Lord, have patience with me, and I will pay thee all.

**27** Then the lord of that servant was moved with compassion, and loosed him, and forgave him the debt.

**28** But the same servant went out, and found one of his fellowservants, which owed him an hundred pence: and he laid hands on him, and took him by the

throat, saying, Pay me that thou owest.

**29** And his fellowservant fell down at his feet, and besought him, saying, Have patience with me, and I will pay thee all.

**30** And he would not: but went and cast him into prison, till he should pay the debt.

**31** So when his fellowservants saw what was done, they were very sorry, and came and told unto their lord all that was done.

**32** Then his lord, after that he had called him, said unto him, O thou wicked servant, I forgave thee all that debt, because thou desiredst me:

**33** Shouldest not thou also have had compassion on thy fellowservant, even as I had pity on thee?

**34** And his lord was wroth, and delivered him to the tormentors, till he should pay all that was due unto him.

**35** So likewise shall my heavenly Father do also unto you, if ye from your hearts forgive not every one his brother their trespasses.

Note the king was willing to forgive and have pity on his servant what appears to be a great amount but the servant was not willing to forgive his fellowservant for a far lesser amount having no compassion on him. God forgives us of all our sins through the blood of Christ. Are we not willing to forgive our fellowservant a far lesser amount for a trespass against us? Remember if it is a fellow brethern then we are not willing to forgive one who God has chosen. Think about it.
