OLD TESTAMENT

CONTRITE HEART (CRUSHED OR POWDERED) Ps34:18, 51:17, Is. 57:15, 66:2

"...saveth such as be of a contrite spirit"

Psa 34:18 The LORD is nigh unto them that are of a broken heart; and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit.

NEW TESTAMENT

"...an honest and good heart,..."

Luke 8:15 But that on the good ground are they, which in an honest and good heart, having heard the word, keep it, and bring forth fruit with patience.

"... he shall not enter therein."

Mark 10:15 Verily I say unto you, Whosoever shall not receive the kingdom of God as a little child, he shall not enter therein.

John 10:27 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:

John 10:28 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand.

REPENT

Luke 13:3 I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish.

CONFESS

Mat 10:32 Whosoever therefore shall confess me before men, him will I confess also before my Father which is in heaven.

Mat 10:33 But whosoever shall deny me before men, him will I also deny before my Father which is in heaven.

BELIEVE

John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

John 3:17 For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.

John 3:18 He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

John 3:19 And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.

John 3:20 For every one that doeth evil hateth the light, neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reproved.

John 3:21 But he that doeth truth cometh to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God.

What does the Bible mean when it says believe? Even the devils believed. Note in chapter 3 of John above verse 16:

John 3:3 Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.

Note after John 3:16:

John 3:21 But he that doeth truth cometh to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God.

You can believe with the mind and seek proof, but when you accept without proof this is faith. Our Humanist schools have taught us not to accept anything as absolute and question everything.

Webster's New Collegiate Dictionary:

PRAGMATISM: "the truth is pre-eminently to be tested by the practical consequences of belief." guide to action. An American philosophical movement founded by C. S. Pierce and William James.

It was later used by John Dewey the father of the Modern Progressive Educational System that our nation holds so high in esteem. It is also taking us down the road to destruction. It has almost stripped our young and many old of the knowledge of what FAITH is. Faith is necessary for salvation. You can see they feel the truth is to be tested rather than accepted. pre-eminently to be tested, practical consequences of belief, guide to action.

Traits of a contrite heart (crushed - powered)

humility, conviction, good heart, repentance, faith, follow, believe in Christ (without proof), fear of the Lord, trust

BELIEVE IN CHRIST (WITHOUT PROOF)

John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

John 3:5 Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.

John 3:6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.

John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.

STANDARD

Isa 62:10 Go through, go through the gates; prepare ye the way of the people; cast up, cast up the highway; gather out the stones; lift up a standard for the people.

PROVERBS: HATE - PROUD LOOK (1st named of the 6)

Prov 6:16 These six things doth the LORD hate: yea, seven are an abomination unto him:

Prov 6:17 **A proud look**, a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent blood,

Prov 6:18 An heart that deviseth wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to mischief,

Prov 6:19 A false witness that speaketh lies, and he that soweth discord among brethren.

JOB – AFRAID TREMBLETH AT GOD

Job 37:1 At this also my heart trembleth, and is moved out of his place.

Job 28:28 And unto man he said, Behold, the fear of the Lord, that is wisdom; and to depart from evil is understanding.

Job 23:15 Therefore am I troubled at his presence: when I consider, I am afraid of him.
Job 23:16 For God maketh my heart soft, and the Almighty troubleth me:

FAITH

Heb 11:1 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

Psa 51:17 The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit: a broken and a contrite heart, O God, thou wilt not despise.

Isa 57:15 For thus saith the high and lofty One that inhabiteth eternity, whose name is Holy; I dwell in the high and holy place, with him also that is of a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones.

Isa 66:2 For all those things hath mine hand made, and all those things have been, saith the LORD: but to this man will I look, even to him that is poor and of a contrite spirit, and *trembleth at my word*.

CONCLUSION; We must have a contrite heart (crushed or powered), or a good heart and humble ourselves before the mighty hand of God believing on His Son realizing we are a sinner, repent (turn away from) and confess our sins. The old man is dead and we turn to the new life in Christ Jesus to work in His kingdom.
