Isaiah 6:10 Make the heart of this people fat, and make their ears heavy, and shut their eyes; lest they see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and **understand with their heart, and convert, and be healed.**

Matthew 13:15 For this people's heart is waxed gross, and *their* ears are dull of hearing, and their eyes they have closed; lest at any time they should see with *their* eyes, and hear with *their* ears, and should **understand with *their* heart,**

and should be converted, and I should heal them.

John 12:40 He hath blinded their eyes, and hardened their heart; that they should not see with *their* eyes, nor **understand with *their* heart**, and be converted, and I should heal them.

Acts 28:27 For the heart of this people is waxed gross, and their ears are dull of hearing, and their eyes have they closed; lest they should see with *their* eyes, and hear with *their* ears, and **understand with *their* heart**, and should be converted, and I should heal them.

Vain

Matthew 15:9 But in **vain** they do worship me, teaching *for* doctrines the commandments of men.

Mark 7:7 Howbeit in **vain** do they worship me, teaching *for* doctrines the commandments of men.

Acts 4:25 Who by the mouth of thy servant David hast said, Why did the heathen rage, and the people imagine **vain** things?

Romans 1:21 Because that, when they knew God, they glorified *him* not as God, neither were thankful; but became **vain** in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.

1 Corinthians 3:20 And again, The Lord knoweth the thoughts of the wise, that they are **vain**.

2 Corinthians 6:1 We then, as workers together *with him*, beseech *you* also that ye receive not the grace of God in **vain**.

Ephesians 5:6 Let no man deceive you with **vain** words: for because of these things cometh the wrath of God upon the children of disobedience.

Philippians 2:16 Holding forth the word of life; that I may rejoice in the day of Christ, that I have not run in **vain**, neither laboured in vain.

1 Thessalonians 3:5 For this cause, when I could no longer forbear, I sent to know your faith, lest by some means the tempter have tempted you, and our labour be in **vain**.
