GOD IS LOVE

1 John 4:8 He that **loveth** not knoweth not God; for God is **love**.

1 John 4:16 And we have known and believed the **love** that God hath to us. God is **love**; and he that dwelleth in **love** dwelleth in God, and God in him.

John 3:16 ¶ For God so **loved** the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

17 For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.

18 ¶ He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

19 And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.

20 For every one that doeth evil hateth the light, neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reprov'd.

21 But he that doeth truth cometh to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God.

Mat 22:36 Master, which is the great commandment in the law?

37 Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt **love** the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind.

38 This is the first and great commandment.

39 And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt **love** thy neighbour as thyself.

40 On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.

John 10:17 Therefore doth my Father **love** me, because I lay down my life, that I might take it again

John 15:13 Greater **love** hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends.

1 John 3:1 Behold, what manner of **love** the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God: therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew him not.

8 He that **loveth** not knoweth not God; for God is **love**.

9 In this was manifested the **love** of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him.

10 Herein is **love**, not that we **loved** God, but that he **loved** us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins. we ought also to **love** one another.

11 Beloved, if God so **loved** us, we ought also to **love** one another.

1 John 5:1 Whosoever believeth that Jesus is the Christ is born of God: and every one that **loveth** him that begat loveth him also that is begotten of him.

2 By this we know that we **love** the children of God, when we **love** God, and keep his commandments.

John 14:15 If ye **love** me, keep my commandments.

21 He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that **loveth** me: and he that **loveth** me shall be **loved** of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him.

John 14:23 Jesus answered and said unto him, If a man **love** me, he will keep my words: and my Father will **love** him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him.

John 14:31 But that the world may know that I **love** the Father; and as the Father gave me commandment, even so I do. Arise, let us go hence.

John 15:12 This is my commandment, That ye **love** one another, as I have loved you.

13 Greater **love** hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends.

14 Ye are my friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you.

John 15:17 These things I command you, that ye **love** one another.

John 15:19 If ye were of the world, the world would love his own: but because ye are not of the world, but I have chosen you out of the world, therefore the world hateth you.

John 21:15 So when they had dined, Jesus saith to Simon Peter, Simon, son of Jonas, **lovest** thou me more than these? He saith unto him, Yea, Lord; thou knowest that I **love** thee. He saith unto him, Feed my lambs.

16 He saith to him again the second time, Simon, son of Jonas, **lovest** thou me? He saith unto him, Yea, Lord; thou knowest that I **love** thee. He saith unto him, Feed my sheep.

17 He saith unto him the third time, Simon, son of Jonas, **lovest** thou me? Peter was grieved because he said unto him the third time, **Lovest** thou me? And he

said unto him, Lord, thou knowest all things; thou knowest that I **love** thee. Jesus saith unto him, Feed my sheep.

Peter had cut off the ear of the servant of the high priest, denied Christ three times and after the crucifixion Peter had gone back to fishing. Peter had traveled some distance from Jerusalem to the Sea of Galilee to take up his old profession. Was it the fish or the fisherman Christ was asking did he love more? Regardless, Christ had gone to him and confronted him questioning his love towards him. After the Lord had sifted Peter and set him on the right road Peter followed the Master until his death. He was a faithful and loyal servant from henceforth. Perhaps our love needs to be tested, we need to be sifted and our feet put on the right road. How many times have we denied the master with our actions and deeds? How many times have we turned back to the old life rather than staying with the new life of the new birth in Christ Jesus? How many times would the Lord have to ask us "...lovest thou me more than these?"
