## Great Tribulation

**Are you one that believes we will be gone and we will not enter the tribulation period?**

### Questions:

You tell me

If we do not enter the great tribulation period please answer the following questions:

- 1.** Why is saints mentioned all the way through Revelation (13 times)? Rev 5:8, 8:3, 8:4, 11:18, 13:7, 13:10, 14:12, 15:3, 16:6, 17:6, 18:24, 19:8, and 20:9.
- 2.** Why does 2 Th. 2:1-4 say that the man of sin must be revealed before the gathering?
- 3.** What is meant by last trump in 1 Cor. 15:52?
- 4.** Why is harvest mentioned only once in Revelation 14:15?
- 5.** What are the firstfruits in Revelation 14:4?

6. Why does Mat. 24:21 refer to the days being shortened if we are not here?
7. If the seventh trumpet is not the last trumpet when does it occur?
8. Why does Dan. 7:13, Rev. 1:7 refer to the Lord coming with a cloud,or clouds and Rev. 14:14-16 refers to cloud 4 times if the rapture occurred almost 7 years before?
9. The book of Revelation is one revelation (singular) and to all 7 churches the word overcometh is stated in Rev. 2,7 ,11, 17, 26, and Rev. 3:5, 12, 21. Why?
10. Why is endure to the end mentioned in Mk. 13:13, Mat. 10:22, Mat.24:13?
11. In Rev, 2:10 why are we told 10 days of tribulation?
12. Why are we told after the tribulation of those days in Mat. 24:29?
13. Why are we told after that tribulation in Mk. 13:24?
14. Why are we told that it would be as the days of Noe as Gen. 7:13 indicates the self same day that Noah entered the ark the unrighteous were destroyed?
15. Why are we told that it would be as in the days of Lot when we are told that his wife looked back and was turned to a pillar of salt? (in sight)

The following questions are in reference to **Matthew chapter 24:**

Why did the disciples ask when and what? v.3

How can we be deceived during the tribulation period if we are not here? v.4

How can we follow false Christs if we are not here? v.5

How can we be delivered up if we are not here? v. 9

How can we be killed if we are not here? v. 9

How can we be hated of all nations if we are not here? v.9

How can we be offended if we are not here? v.10

How can we be betrayed if we are not here? v.10

How can we hate one another if we are not here? v.10

How can our love wax cold if we are not here? v.12

How can we endure to the end if we are not here? v.13

Why will the gospel be preached into all the world if we are gone? v.14

How can we see the abomination of desolation if we are not here? v.15

How can these days be shortened for the elect's sake if we are not here? v.22

How can we be deceived by great signs and wonders if we are not here? v.24

Why are the elect being gathered if we have been gone since before the 7 years began? v.31

How can we see all these things if we are not here? v.33

How can it be as the days of Noe if we are not here? v.37

Why are 18 pronouns used in this chapter referring to the disciples from whom the questions when and what in verse 3 were ask?

## Questions:

What does 2Th. 2:3 say must take place before Christ return?

*"...for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first..."*

*"...that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;..."*

**2 Th 2:3** Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;

The man of sin, or the son of perdition, or the beast does not reveal himself until he stands in the temple of God and proclaims himself to be above all gods. This is when the daily sacrifice is cut off and THE ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION starts. Note, it does not say that Christ will return immediately after this takes place but it states these must take place beforehand. I refer you back to 2Th. 2:1 referring to the gathering together unto him.

What is the last trump?

*"...at the last trump..."*

**1 Cor 15:52** In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

Please look up in the Greek and see if the same Greek word is not used here and for the seven trumpets in Revelation. This does not mean the seventh trumpet is the last trumpet, but if not it must of necessity be after it.

**If you are going to be gone before the tribulation you should be able to answer most or all the previous questions.** Certainly you should know who the man of sin is and the son of perdition.

An old Grecian Philosopher once said you can come to the truth by asking questions. Did you?
