1. SALVATION

The Lord becomes our saviour, rescuing us from eternal death and sin delivering us to safety and becoming our defender, as a result of our faith and acceptance of Jesus Christ who died on Calvary's cross for our sins.

Rom 1:16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.

Rom 1:17 For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith.

1 Th 5:9 For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ,

2. FEAR OF THE LORD.

Psa 111:10 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: a good understanding have all they that do his commandments: his praise endureth for ever.

Prov 1:7 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge: but fools despise wisdom and instruction.

3. FAITH

WHAT IS FAITH?

Heb 11:1 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

Our modern society has been taught that faith and belief are interchangeable. Please note that faith comes from the heart and does not require proof but acceptance. A modern day person may believe from the mind and not the heart and be a critic and question. When we question there is doubt and then doubt destroys faith. The belief has to come from the heart without proof and then acceptance. Reason is the Humanist highest appeal. The WORD OF GOD and God Himself is the highest appeal to the Christian. Acceptance is without question.

Pragmatism is John Dewey's way of teaching for the modern Progressive Educational System. Please note: Webster's New Collegiate Dictionary copyright 1953 PRAGMATISM: "...The truth is pre-eminently to be tested by the practical consequences of belief ... guide to action." Truth can only be believed when it is pre-eminently tested by reason. In short we cannot accept by faith without proof. Biblical faith is accepting without proof, In other words how can a person be saved when they have to be critical and question? Doubt or question destroys faith.

Question young people that you know to see if they do not think belief and faith are the same thing. A person can have faith and believe but a person can believe and not be willing to accept without proof. Why do we have 230 versions of the Bible if it is not being questioned or criticized?

If we truly believed God we would believe His Word (The Bible) without question and would not criticize His Word but accept Him and His Word without proof. What ever the Bible says we would accept. His Word would be an absolute and could not and would not be changed. We either believe God or we do not.

4. BELIEF

Rom 10:9 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.

Rom 10:10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

5. CONTRITE HEART

CONTRITE: DEFINITION – crushed – powder-crumble-mentally or physically break

CONTRITE HEART

Psa 34:18 The LORD is nigh unto them that are of a broken heart; and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit.

Isa 57:13 When thou criest, let thy companies deliver thee; but the wind shall carry them all away; vanity shall take them: but he that putteth his trust in me shall possess the land, and shall inherit my holy mountain;

Isa 57:14 And shall say, Cast ye up, cast ye up, prepare the way, take up the stumbling block out of the way of my people.

Isa 57:15 For thus saith the high and lofty One that inhabiteth eternity, whose name is Holy; I dwell in the high and holy place, with him also that is of a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones

6. HUMBLE

Psa 10:17 LORD, thou hast heard the desire of the humble: thou wilt prepare their heart, thou wilt cause thine ear to hear:
