Deu. 5:11 Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain: for the LORD will not hold *him* guiltless that taketh his name in vain.

Ex. 20:1 And God spake all these words, saying,

4 COMMANDMENTS CONCERNING GOD

- I. Ex. 20:3 Thou shalt have no other gods before me.
- II. Ex. 20:4-6
 - 4 Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness *of any thing* that *is* in heaven above, or that *is* in the earth beneath, or that *is* in the water under the earth:
 - 5Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD **thy** God *am* a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the

fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth *generation* of them that hate me;

6 And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.

- III. Ex. 20:7 Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain; for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain.
- IV. Ex. 20:8-11
- 8 Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy.

7 ¶ The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of knowledge: *but* fools despise wisdom and instruction.

BYWORD

See the following scriptures where God will punish Israel by making them a byword among all people and the nations. We make God a byword in our modern society. Why? The answer is simply, we are either ignorant or do not fear God. I suspect it may be a little of both.

Deut. 28:37 And thou shalt become an astonishment, a proverb, and a **byword**, among all nations whither the LORD shall lead thee.

1Kings 9:7 Then will I cut off Israel out of the land which I have given them; and this house, which I have hallowed for my name, will I cast out of my sight; and Israel shall be a proverb and a **byword** among all people:

2 Chr. 7:20 Then will I pluck them up by the roots out of my land which I have given them; and this house, which I have sanctified for my name, will I cast out of my sight, and will make it *to be* a proverb and a **byword** among all nations.

Job 17:6 He hath made me also a **byword** of the people; and aforetime I was as a tabret.

Job 30:9 And now am I their song, yea, I am their **byword**.

Psalms 40:14

Psalms 40:14 Thou makest us a **byword** among the heathen, a shaking of the head among the people.

Deu. 5:9 Thou shalt not bow down thyself unto them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God *am* a **jealous God**, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth *generation* of them that hate me,

Deu 6:15 (For the LORD thy God *is* a **jealous God** among you) lest the anger of the LORD thy God be kindled against thee, and destroy thee from off the face of the earth.

Joshua 24:19 And Joshua said unto the people, Ye cannot serve the LORD: for he *is* an holy God; he *is* a **jealous God**; he will not forgive your transgressions nor your sins.

Joshua 24:20 If ye forsake the LORD, and serve strange gods, then he will turn and do you hurt, and consume you, after that he hath done you good.
