

# THOUSAND YEARS

**Yes, Christ will reign here on this earth for a thousand years.**

**This will be at the close of the seven years tribulation period at Christ's return to this earth.**

**The seven years tribulation period could start any time.**

**Rev 20:1** And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand.

**Rev 20:2** And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him **a thousand years**,

**Rev 20:3** And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till **the thousand years** should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season.

**Rev 20:4** And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ **a thousand years**.

**Rev 20:5** But the rest of the dead lived not again until **the thousand years** were finished. This is the first resurrection.

**Rev 20:6** Blessed and holy is he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him **a thousand years**.

## HE WILL RULE WITH A ROD OF IRON

**“...Jerusalem is ruined,...”**

**Isa 3:8** For Jerusalem is ruined, and Judah is fallen: because their tongue and their doings

are against the LORD, to provoke the eyes of his glory.

**“...purged;...”**

**Isa 27:9** By this therefore shall the iniquity of Jacob be purged; and this is all the fruit to take away his sin; when he maketh all the stones of the altar as chalkstones that are beaten in sunder, the groves and images shall not stand up.

**Isa 27:10** Yet the defenced city shall be desolate, and the habitation forsaken, and left like a wilderness: there shall the calf feed, and there shall he lie down, and consume the branches thereof.

**“...strong hand,...”**

**Isa 40:10** Behold, the Lord GOD will come with strong hand, and his arm shall rule for him: behold, his reward is with him, and his work before him.

**“...set up my standard to the people:...”**

**Isa 49:22** Thus saith the Lord GOD, Behold, I will lift up mine hand to the Gentiles, and set up my standard to the people: and they shall bring thy sons in their arms, and thy daughters shall be carried upon their shoulders.

**Isa 49:23** And kings shall be thy nursing fathers, and their queens thy nursing mothers: they shall bow down to thee with their face toward the earth, and lick up the dust of thy feet; and thou shalt know that I am the LORD: for they shall not be ashamed that wait for me.

**“...shall inherit my holy mountain;...”**

**Isa 57:13** When thou criest, let thy companies deliver thee; but the wind shall carry them all away; vanity shall take them: but he that putteth his trust in me shall possess the land, and shall inherit my holy mountain;

**“...cast up, cast up the highway;...”**

**Isa 62:10** Go through, go through the gates; prepare ye the way of the people; cast up, cast up the highway; gather out the stones; lift up a standard for the people.

**“...The holy people,...” (Isa 62:12)**

**Isa 62:11** Behold, the LORD hath proclaimed unto the end of the world, Say ye to the daughter of Zion, Behold, thy salvation cometh; behold, his reward is with him, and his work before him.

**Isa 62:12** And they shall call them, The holy people, The redeemed of the LORD: and thou shalt be called, Sought out, A city not forsaken.

**“...I will not be inquired of by you.”**

**Ezek 20:31** For when ye offer your gifts, when ye make your sons to pass through the fire, ye pollute yourselves with all your idols, even unto this day: and shall I be inquired of by you, O house of Israel? As I live, saith the Lord GOD, I will not be inquired of by you.

**“...shall take hold of the skirt of him that is a Jew,...”**

**Zec 8:23** Thus saith the LORD of hosts; In those days it shall come to pass, that ten men shall take hold out of all languages of the nations, even shall take hold of the skirt of him that is a Jew, saying, We will go with you: for we have heard that God is with you.

**“...no rain.” (Zec 14:17)**

**Zec 14:16** And it shall come to pass, that every one that is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall even go up from year to year to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, and to keep the feast of tabernacles.

**Zec 14:17** And it shall be, that whoso will not come up of all the families of the earth unto Jerusalem to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, even upon them shall be no rain.

**“...rod of iron:...”**

**Rev 12:5** And she brought forth a man child, who was to rule all nations with **a rod of iron:** and her child was caught up unto God, and to his throne.

**Rev 19:15** And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with **a rod of iron:** and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

## **TOPOGRAPHY**

**(Lay Out Of The Land During The 1000 Year Reign)**

**“...cloud and smoke...”**

**Isa 4:5** And the LORD will create upon every dwelling place of mount Zion, and upon her assemblies, a cloud and smoke by day, and the shining of a flaming fire by night: for upon all the glory shall be a defence.

**“...destroy the tongue of the Egyptian sea;...”**

**Isa 11:15** And the LORD shall utterly destroy the tongue of the Egyptian sea; and with his mighty wind shall he shake his hand over the river, and shall smite it in the seven streams, and make men go over dryshod.

**“...highway...”**

**Isa 35:8** And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err therein.

**“...fountains...”**

**Isa 41:18** I will open rivers in high places, and fountains in the midst of the valleys: I will make the wilderness a pool of water, and the dry land springs of water.

**“...rivers in the desert.”**

**Isa 43:19** Behold, I will do a new thing; now it shall spring forth; shall ye not know it? I will even make a way in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert.

**“...fish of the great sea, exceeding many.” (Ezek 47:10)**

**Ezek 47:9** And it shall come to pass, that every thing that liveth, which moveth, whithersoever the rivers shall come, shall live: and there shall be a very great multitude of fish, because these waters shall come thither: for they shall be healed; and every thing shall live whither the river cometh.

**Ezek 47:10** And it shall come to pass, that the fishers shall stand upon it from Engedi even unto Eneglaim; they shall be a place to spread forth nets; their fish shall be according to their kinds, as the fish of the great sea, exceeding many.

**Ezek 47:11** But the miry places thereof and the marshes thereof shall not be healed; they shall be given to salt.

**“...mountain of the house of the LORD...”**

**Micah 4:1** But in the last days it shall come to pass, that the mountain of the house of the LORD shall be established in the top of the mountains, and it shall be exalted above the hills; and people shall flow unto it.

**Micah 4:2** And many nations shall come, and say, Come, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, and to the house of the God of Jacob; and he will teach us of his ways, and we will walk in his paths: for the law shall go forth of Zion, and the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.

**“...become a plain:...”**

**Zec 4:7** Who art thou, O great mountain? before Zerubbabel thou shalt become a plain: and he shall bring forth the headstone thereof with shoutings, crying, Grace, grace unto it.

**“...very great valley;...”**

**Zec 14:4** And his feet shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives, which is before Jerusalem on the east, and the mount of Olives shall cleave in the midst thereof toward the east and toward the west, and there shall be a very great valley; and half of the mountain shall remove toward the north, and half of it toward the south.

**“...half of them toward the former sea, and half of them toward the hinder sea:...”**

**Zec 14:8** And it shall be in that day, that living waters shall go out from Jerusalem; half of them toward the former sea, and half of them toward the hinder sea: in summer and in winter shall it be.

**“...shall be turned as a plain...”**

**Zec 14:10** All the land shall be turned as a plain from Geba to Rimmon south of Jerusalem: and it shall be lifted up, and inhabited in her place, from Benjamin's gate unto the place of the first gate, unto the corner gate, and from the tower of Hananeel unto the king's winepresses.

**“...make up my jewels...”**

**Mal 3:17** **And they shall be mine, saith the LORD of hosts, in that day when I make up my jewels; and I will spare them, as a man spareth his own son that serveth him.**

**Mal 3:18** **Then shall ye return, and discern between the righteous and the wicked, between him that serveth God and him that serveth him not.**

## **DO YOU SERVE HIM? ARE YOU ONE OF HIS?**

We will have a period of seven years of tribulation on this earth. In the midst of this period of time the beast will control the entire earth 42 months. **Rev 20:4 And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.**

## **BLESSINGS OF THE ELECT**

The following are blessings that are given to the elect of Israel in the thousand year reign. It is amazing what will happen when sin is removed. Underlining and bold print is only to draw the attention of the reader to the blessing that is referred to.

**Isa 5:26** And he will lift up an ensign to the nations from far, and will hiss unto them from the end of the earth: and, behold, they shall come with speed swiftly:

**Isa 7:18** And it shall come to pass in that day, that the LORD shall hiss for the fly that is in the uttermost part of the rivers of Egypt, and for the bee that is in the land of Assyria.

NOTE: Bees are used for pollination and in some areas flies. It will be like the Garden of Eden.

**Isa 7:21** And it shall come to pass in that day, that a man shall nourish a young cow, and two sheep;

**Isa 7:22** And it shall come to pass, for the abundance of milk that they shall give he shall eat butter: for butter and honey shall every one eat that is left in the land.

**Isa 7:25** And on all hills that shall be digged with the mattock, there shall not come thither the fear of briars and thorns: but it shall be for the sending forth of oxen, and for the treading of lesser cattle.

**Isa 9:7** Of the increase of his government and peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.

**Isa 14:2** And the people shall take them, and bring them to their place: and the house of Israel shall possess them in the land of the LORD for servants and handmaids: and they shall take them captives, whose captives they were; and they shall rule over their oppressors.

**Isa 14:7** The whole earth is at rest, and is quiet: they break forth into singing.

**Isa 35:1** The wilderness and the solitary place shall be glad for them; and the desert shall rejoice, and blossom as the rose.

**Isa 35:3** Strengthen ye the weak hands, and confirm the feeble knees.

**Isa 35:5** Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, and the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped.

**Isa 35:6** Then shall the lame man leap as an hart, and the tongue of the dumb sing: for in the wilderness shall waters break out, and streams in the desert.

**Isa 35:7** And the parched ground shall become a pool, and the thirsty land springs of water: in the habitation of dragons, where each lay, shall be grass with reeds and rushes.

**Isa 35:8** And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err therein.

**Isa 35:9** No lion shall be there, nor any ravenous beast shall go up thereon, it shall not be found there; but the redeemed shall walk there:

**Isa 35:10** And the ransomed of the LORD shall return, and come to Zion with songs and everlasting joy upon their heads: they shall obtain joy and gladness, and sorrow and sighing shall flee away.

**Isa 41:18** I will open rivers in high places, and fountains in the midst of the valleys: I will make the wilderness a pool of water, and the dry land springs of water.

**Isa 60:11** Therefore thy gates shall be open continually; they shall not be shut day nor night; that men may bring unto thee the forces of the Gentiles, and that their kings may be brought.

**Isa 62:4** Thou shalt no more be termed Forsaken; neither shall thy land any more be termed Desolate: but thou shalt be called Hephzibah, and thy land Beulah: for the LORD delighteth in thee, and thy land shall be married.

**Isa 62:7** And give him no rest, till he establish, and till he make Jerusalem a praise in the earth.

**Isa 65:20** There shall be no more thence an infant of days, nor an old man that hath not filled his days: for the child shall die an hundred years old; but the sinner being an hundred years old shall be accursed.

NOTE: Shepherds would have the sheep go under the rod to make sure they were theirs and that they had them all. Other sheep were kept out.

**Ezek 20:38** And I will purge out from among you the rebels, and them that transgress against me: I will bring them forth out of the country where they sojourn, and they shall not enter into the land of Israel: and ye shall know that I am the LORD.

**Ezek 20:40** For in mine holy mountain, in the mountain of the height of Israel, saith the Lord GOD, there shall all the house of Israel, all of them in the land, serve me: there will I accept them, and there will I require your offerings, and the firstfruits of your oblations, with all your holy things.

**Ezek 20:41** I will accept you with your sweet savour, when I bring you out from the people, and gather you out of the countries wherein ye have been scattered; and I will be sanctified in you before the heathen.

NOTE: All the house of Israel includes the lost tribes of Israel.

**Ezek 47:9** And it shall come to pass, that every thing that liveth, which moveth, whithersoever the rivers shall come, shall live: and there shall be a very great multitude of fish, because these waters shall come thither: for they shall be healed; and every thing shall live whither the river cometh.

**Ezek 47:10** And it shall come to pass, that the fishers shall stand upon it from Engedi even unto Eneglaim; they shall be a place to spread forth nets; their fish shall be according to their kinds, as the fish of the great sea, exceeding many.

**Ezek 47:11** But the miry places thereof and the marshes thereof shall not be healed; they shall be given to salt.

**Zec 6:12** And speak unto him, saying, Thus speaketh the LORD of hosts, saying, Behold the man whose name is **The BRANCH**; and he shall grow up out of his place, and **he shall build the temple of the LORD**:

Let us look at (1) Transportation, (2) Fruit, (3) The Lord Providing (4) Healing taking place during this period of time and (5) Deliverance.

## TRANSPORTATION:

“...horses,...” (a.)  
“...chariots,...” (b.)  
“...litters,...” (c.)  
“...mules,...” (d.)  
“...swift beasts,...” (e.)

**Isa 66:20** And they shall bring all your brethren for an offering unto the LORD out of all nations upon horses, and in chariots, and in litters, and upon mules, and upon swift beasts, to my holy mountain Jerusalem, saith the LORD, as the children of Israel bring an offering in a clean vessel into the house of the LORD.

“...carried upon their shoulders.”

**Isa 49:22** Thus saith the Lord GOD, Behold, I will lift up mine hand to the Gentiles, and set up my standard to the people: and they shall bring thy sons in their arms, and thy daughters shall be carried upon their shoulders.

“...no gally with oars,...” (a.)  
“...neither shall gallant ship pass thereby.” (b.)

**Isa 33:21** But there the glorious LORD will be unto us a place of broad rivers and streams; wherein shall go no galley with oars, neither shall gallant ship pass thereby.

**Isa 33:22** For the LORD is our judge, the LORD is our lawgiver, the LORD is our king; he will save us.

“Thy tacklings are loosed;...” (a.)  
“...not well strengthen their mast,...” (b.)  
“...not spread the sail:...” (c.)

**Isa 33:23** Thy tacklings are loosed; they could not well strengthen their mast, they could not spread the sail: then is the prey of a great spoil divided; the lame take the

Please note that ships will come to Jerusalem, near Zion, which is now located in the mountains? Note the tacklings are loosed, their mast not strengthened, and they will not spread their sails. It appears that they will come slowly and quietly. The waters that flow in front of the temple will separate and part will flow to the former sea and part to the hinder sea. Zec. 14:8 (It appears these are the Dead Sea and the Great Sea) With these vessels at hand it is easy to see how Israel will fill the earth with fruit in Isa. 27:6 below. There will be a lot of geographical changes made between now and then.

## FRUIT:

**“...fruit of the earth shall be excellent...”**

**Isa 4:2** In that day shall the branch of the LORD be beautiful and glorious, and the fruit of the earth shall be excellent and comely for them that are escaped of Israel.

**“...fill the face of the world with fruit.”**

**Isa 27:6** He shall cause them that come of Jacob to take root: Israel shall blossom and bud, and fill the face of the world with fruit.

**“...plant vineyards, and eat fruit of them.”**

**Isa 65:21** And they shall build houses, and inhabit them; and they shall plant vineyards, and eat the fruit of them.

**“...vineyard of red wine .”**

**Isa 27:2** In that day sing ye unto her, A vineyard of red wine.

**“...hiss for the fly---and for the bee...”**

**Isa 7:18** And it shall come to pass in that day, that the LORD shall hiss for the fly that is in the uttermost part of the rivers of Egypt, and for the bee that is in the land of Assyria.

The above suggest the purpose of calling the fly and bee is for pollination.

**“...the fruit of the tree,...”**

**Ezek 36:30** And I will multiply the fruit of the tree, and the increase of the field, that ye shall receive no more reproach of famine among the heathen.

**“...all trees for meat,...”**

**Ezek 47:12** And by the river upon the bank thereof, on this side and on that side, shall grow all trees for meat, whose leaf shall not fade, neither shall the fruit thereof be consumed: it shall bring forth new fruit according to his months, because their waters they issued out of the sanctuary: and the fruit thereof shall be for meat, and the leaf thereof for medicine.

The living waters that flow from the sanctuary will heal whatever it touches. (Ezekiel 47:9) The trees are upon the bank and the fruit cannot be consumed. I take this to mean that the fruit will continue to come forth as picked. Note the earth will be filled with fruit and the leaves will be for medicine.

## **LORD PROVIDES**

**“...butter and honey shall every one eat...”**

**Isa 7:22** And it shall come to pass, for the abundance of milk that they

shall give he shall eat butter: for butter and honey shall every one eat that is left in the land.

**“...great multitude of fish,...”**

**Ezek 47:9** And it shall come to pass, that every thing that liveth, which moveth, whithersoever the rivers shall come, shall live: and there shall be a very great multitude of fish, because these waters shall come thither: for they shall be healed; and every thing shall live whither the river cometh.

**“...ye shall eat in plenty,...” (Joel 2:26)**

**Joel 2:25** And I will restore to you the years that the locust hath eaten, the cankerworm, and the caterpillar, and the palmerworm, my great army which I sent among you.

**Joel 2:26** And ye shall eat in plenty, and be satisfied, and praise the name of the L0RD your God, that hath dealt wondrously with you: and my people shall never be ashamed.

**“...the former rain, and the latter rain...”**

**Joel 2:23** Be glad then, ye children of Zion, and rejoice in the L0RD your God: for he hath given you the former rain moderately, and he will cause to come down for you the rain, the former rain, and the latter rain in the first month.

**“...the land is as the garden of Eden...”**

**Joel 2:3** A fire devoureth before them; and behind them a flame burneth: the land is as the garden of Eden before them, and behind them a desolate wilderness; yea, and nothing shall escape them.

**“...the mountains shall drop sweet wine,...”**

**Amos 9:13** Behold, the days come, saith the L0RD, that the plowman shall overtake the reaper, and the treader of grapes him that soweth seed; and the mountains shall drop sweet wine, and all the hills shall melt.

**“...neither shall they learn war any more.”**

**Micah 4:3** And he shall judge among many people, and rebuke strong nations afar off; and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruninghooks: nation shall not lift up a sword against nation, neither shall they learn war any more.

**“...none shall make them afraid:...”**

**Micah 4:4** But they shall sit every man under his vine and under his fig tree; and none shall make them afraid: for the mouth of the L0RD of hosts hath spoken it.

## HEAL

**“...deaf hear - - eyes of the blind shall see...”**

**Isa 29:18** And in that day shall the deaf hear the words of the book, and the eyes of the blind shall see out of obscurity, and out of darkness.

**“...shall not say, I am sick:...”**

**Isa 33:24** And the inhabitant shall not say, I am sick: the people that dwell therein shall be forgiven their iniquity.

**“Strengthen ye the weak hands,...”**

**Isa 35:3** Strengthen ye the weak hands, and confirm the feeble knees.

**“...eyes of the blind shall be opened,...”**

**Isa 35:5** Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, and the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped.

**“...lame man leap - - - tongue of the dumb sing:...”**

**Isa 35:6** Then shall the lame man leap as an hart, and the tongue of the dumb sing: for in the wilderness shall waters break out, and streams in the desert.

**“...waters to swim in,...”**

**Ezek 47:5** Afterward he measured a thousand; and it was a river that I could not pass over: for the waters were risen, waters to swim in, a river that could not be passed over.

**“...the waters shall be healed.”**

**Ezek 47:8** Then said he unto me, These waters issue out toward the east country, and go down into the desert, and go into the sea: which being brought forth into the sea, the waters shall be healed.

**Ezek 47:9** And it shall come to pass, that every thing that liveth, which moveth, whithersoever the rivers shall come, shall live: and there shall be a very great multitude of fish, because these waters shall come thither: for they shall be healed; and every thing shall live whither the river cometh.

**“...the leaf thereof for medicine.”**

**Ezek 47:12** And by the river upon the bank thereof, on this side and on that side, shall grow all trees for meat, whose leaf shall not fade, neither shall the fruit thereof be consumed: it shall bring forth new fruit according to his months, because their waters they issued out of the sanctuary: and the fruit thereof shall be for meat, and the leaf thereof for medicine.

**“...shall bring all your brethren for an offering unto the LORD...”**

**Isa 66:20** And they shall bring all your brethren for an offering unto the LORD out of all nations upon horses, and in chariots, and in

litters, and upon mules, and upon swift beasts, to my holy mountain Jerusalem, saith the LORD, as the children of Israel bring an offering in a clean vessel into the house of the LORD.

## **DELIVERANCE**

**“...whosoever shall call on the name of the LORD shall be delivered:...”**  
**Joel 2:32** And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the LORD shall be delivered: for in mount Zion and in Jerusalem shall be deliverance, as the LORD hath said, and in the remnant whom the LORD shall call.

**“...Judah shall dwell for ever,...”**

**Joel 3:20** But Judah shall dwell for ever, and Jerusalem from generation to generation.

**“...Jerusalem a praise in the earth.”**

**Isa 62:7** And give him no rest, till he establish, and till he make Jerusalem a praise in the earth.

**“...The redeemed of the LORD:...”**

**Isa 62:12** And they shall call them, The holy people, The redeemed of the LORD: and thou shalt be called, Sought out, A city not forsaken.

## **WILL THE GENTILES BE HERE IN THE 1,000 YEAR REIGN OF CHRIST?**

(Gentiles - referring to a foreign nation or those nations outside of Israel)

**“...will hiss unto them from the end of the earth: and, behold, they shall come with speed swiftly:...”**

**Isa 5:26** And he will lift up an ensign to the nations from far, and will hiss unto them from the end of the earth: and, behold, they shall come with speed swiftly:

**“...to it shall the Gentiles seek:...”**

**Isa 11:10** And in that day there shall be a root of Jesse, which shall stand for an ensign of the people; to it shall the Gentiles seek: and his rest shall be glorious.

**“...the house of Israel shall possess them in the land of the LORD for servants and handmaids:...”**

**Isa 14:2** And the people shall take them, and bring them to their place: and the house of Israel shall possess them in the land of the LORD for servants and handmaids: and they shall take them captives, whose captives they were; and they shall rule over their oppressors.

**"...the Egyptians shall serve with the Assyrians..."**

Isa 19:23 In that day shall there be a highway out of **Egypt to Assyria**, and the Assyrian shall come into Egypt, and the Egyptian into Assyria, and the Egyptians shall serve with the Assyrians.

**"...the nation and kingdom that will not serve thee shall perish..."(Isa.60:12)**

Isa 60:11 Therefore thy gates shall be open continually; they shall not be shut day nor night; that men may bring unto thee the forces of the **Gentiles**, and that their kings may be brought.

Isa 60:12 For the **nation** and kingdom that will not serve thee shall perish; yea, those nations shall be utterly wasted.

**"...I will send those that escape of them unto the nations..." (Isa. 66:19)**

Isa 66:18 For I know their works and their thoughts: it shall come, that I will gather **all nations** and tongues; and they shall come, and see my glory.

Isa 66:19 And I will set a sign among them, and I will send those that escape of them unto the **nations**, to Tarshish, Pul, and Lud, that draw the bow, to Tubal, and Javan, to the isles afar off, that have not heard my fame, neither have seen my glory; and they shall declare my glory among the **Gentiles**.

Isa 66:20 And they shall bring all your brethren for an offering unto the LORD out of **all nations** upon horses, and in chariots, and in litters, and upon mules, and upon swift beasts, to my holy mountain Jerusalem, saith the LORD, as the children of Israel bring an offering in a clean vessel into the house of the LORD.

**"...all flesh come to worship before me..."**

Isa 66:23 And it shall come to pass, that from one new moon to another, and from one sabbath to another, shall all flesh come to worship before me, saith the LORD.

**"... I will sell your sons and your daughters into the hand of the children of Judah..."**  
(Joel 3:8)

Joel 3:6 The children also of Judah and the children of Jerusalem have ye sold unto the **Grecians**, that ye might remove them far from their border.

Joel 3:7 Behold, I will raise them out of the place whither ye have sold them, and will return your recompense upon your own head:

Joel 3:8 And I will sell your sons and your daughters into the hand of the children of Judah, and they shall sell them to the **Sabeans**, to a people far off: for the LORD hath spoken it.

**"...many nations shall come..."(Micah 4:2)**

Micah 4:1 But in the last days it shall come to pass, that the mountain of the house of the LORD shall be established in the top of the mountains, and it shall be exalted above the hills; and people shall flow unto it.

Micah 4:2 And **many nations** shall come, and say, Come, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, and to the house of the God of Jacob; and he will teach us of his ways, and we will walk in his paths: for the law shall go forth of Zion, and the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.

Micah 4:3 And he shall judge among many people, and rebuke **strong nations** afar off; and

they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruninghooks: nation shall not lift up a sword against nation, neither shall they learn war any more.

**“...out of all languages of the nations...”**

Zec 8:23 Thus saith the LORD of hosts; In those days it shall come to pass, that ten men shall take hold out of all languages of the **nations**, even shall take hold of the skirt of him that is a Jew, saying, We will go with you: for we have heard that God is with you.

**“...every one that is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem...”**

Zec 14:16 And it shall come to pass, that every one that is left of all the **nations** which came against Jerusalem shall even go up from year to year to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, and to keep the feast of tabernacles.

Zec 14:17 And it shall be, that whoso will not come up of **all the families of the earth** unto Jerusalem to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, even upon them shall be no rain.

Zec 14:18 And if the family of Egypt go not up, and come not, that have no rain; there shall be the plague, wherewith the LORD will smite the heathen that come not up to keep the feast of tabernacles.

Zec 14:19 This shall be the punishment of Egypt, and the punishment of **all nations** that come not up to keep the feast of tabernacles.

Zec 14:20 In that day shall there be upon the bells of the horses, HOLINESS UNTO THE LORD; and the pots in the LORD'S house shall be like the bowls before the altar.

Zec 14:21 Yea, every pot in Jerusalem and in Judah shall be holiness unto the LORD of hosts: and all they that sacrifice shall come and take of them, and seethe therein: and in that day there shall be no more the Canaanite in the house of the LORD of hosts.

**“...put all enemies under his feet....”**

1 Cor 15:25 For he must reign, till he hath put all enemies under his feet.

## **WILL THERE BE SIN IN THE 1000 YEAR REIGN?**

Years ago I had a well learned deacon to get upset at me and turn walking off because I had said I believe there would be sin in the 1000 year reign of Christ here on this earth. Any sin will weigh heavy and it will later be done away with completely after the great white throne of judgment. Christ will rule with a rod of iron. At the end of the 1000 year reign Satan will gather forces to come against the Lord. How could Satan find those willing to follow him if there were no sinners. For 1000 years Satan will be in the bottomless pit. Let us take a look at some of the scriptures that address this issue.

Gen 2:17 But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.

*Was this not when sin and death entered the world?*

1 Cor 15:25 For he must reign, till he hath put all enemies under his feet.

1 Cor 15:26 The last enemy that shall be destroyed is death.

*Does sin not leave the earth when death is destroyed?*

*When does death leave the world?*

Rev 20:14 And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.  
Rev 20:15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.

*Were there not sinners until those not found written in the book of life were cast into the lake of fire after the 1000 year reign.*

Ezek 44:9 Thus saith the Lord GOD; **No stranger, uncircumcised in heart, nor uncircumcised in flesh,** shall enter into my sanctuary, of any stranger that is among the children of Israel.

*Who is a stranger?*

Zec 12:6 In that day will I make the governors of Judah like an hearth of fire among the wood, and like a torch of fire in a sheaf; and **they shall devour all the people round about**, on the right hand and on the left: and Jerusalem shall be inhabited again in her own place, even in Jerusalem.

*Who will Judah devour?*

Zec 14:14 And Judah also shall fight at Jerusalem; and the wealth of all the heathen round about shall be gathered together, gold, and silver, and apparel, in great abundance.

*Who will Judah fight?*

Rev 20:7 And when the thousand years are expired, Satan shall be loosed out of his prison,

Rev 20:8 And shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to **battle: the number of whom is as the sand of the sea.**

Rev 20:9 And they went up on the breadth of the earth, and compassed the camp of the saints about, and the beloved city: and fire came down from God out of heaven, and devoured them.

Rev 20:10 And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.

*Who will Satan gather?*

*Was this not sinners gathered?*

Zec 13:2 And it shall come to pass in that day, saith the LORD of hosts, that I will cut off the names of the idols out of the land, and they shall no more be remembered: and also I will cause the **prophets and the unclean spirit to pass out of the land.**

Zec 13:3 And it shall come to pass, that when any shall yet prophesy, then his father and his mother that begat him shall say unto him, Thou shalt not live; for thou speakest lies in the name of the LORD: and **his father and his mother that begat him shall thrust him through when he prophesieth.**

*Are the prophets mentioned above not sinners?*

Zec 5:1 Then I turned, and lifted up mine eyes, and looked, and behold a flying roll.

Zec 5:2 And he said unto me, What seest thou? And I answered, I see a flying roll; the length thereof is twenty cubits, and the breadth thereof ten cubits.

Zec 5:3 Then said he unto me, This is the curse that goeth forth over the face of the whole earth: for every one that **stealeth** shall be cut off as on this side according to it; and every one that **swearereth** shall be cut off as on that side according to it.  
Zec 5:4 I will bring it forth, saith the LORD of hosts, and it shall enter into the house of the thief, and into the house of him that **swearereth falsely** by my name: and it shall remain in the midst of his house, and shall consume it with the timber thereof and the stones thereof.

*Is stealing and swearing falsely sinning?*

Zec 5:5 Then the angel that talked with me went forth, and said unto me, Lift up now thine eyes, and see what is this that goeth forth.  
Zec 5:6 And I said, What is it? And he said, This is an ephah that goeth forth. He said moreover, This is their resemblance through all the earth.  
Zec 5:7 And, behold, there was lifted up a talent of lead: and this is a woman that sitteth in the midst of the ephah.  
Zec 5:8 And he said, **This is wickedness.** And he cast it into the midst of the ephah; and he cast the weight of lead upon the mouth thereof.  
Zec 5:9 Then lifted I up mine eyes, and looked, and, behold, there came out two women, and the wind was in their wings; for they had wings like the wings of a stork: and they lifted up the ephah between the earth and the heaven.  
Zec 5:10 Then said I to the angel that talked with me, Whither do these bear the ephah?  
Zec 5:11 And he said unto me, To build it an house in the land of Shinar: and it shall be established, and set there upon her own base.

Is wickedness no sin in Zec. 5:8.

Isa 49:25 But thus saith the LORD, Even the captives of the mighty shall be taken away, and the prey of the terrible shall be delivered: for I will contend with him that **contendeth with thee**, and I will save thy children.  
Isa 49:26 And I will feed them that oppress thee with their own flesh; and they shall be drunken with their own blood, as with sweet wine: and all flesh shall know that I the LORD am thy Saviour and thy Redeemer, the mighty One of Jacob.

*Is the Lord not contending with sinners?*

Isa 60:12 For the nation and kingdom that will not serve thee shall perish; yea, those nations shall be utterly wasted.

*Who is to perish?*

Isa 60:18 Violence shall no more be heard in thy land, wasting nor destruction within thy borders; but thou shalt call thy walls Salvation, and thy gates Praise.

*Does this verse in any way indicate that violence, wasting or destruction is not happening outside of Israel?*

Zec 14:17 And it shall be, that whoso will not come up of all the families of the earth unto Jerusalem to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, even upon them **shall be no rain.**

*Is not the withholding of rain punishment for sin?*

Rev 21:8 But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.

*Does not the second death occur after the 1000 year reign?*

Zec 12:7 The LORD also shall save the tents of Judah first, that the glory of the house of David and the glory of the inhabitants of Jerusalem do not magnify themselves against Judah.

Zec 12:8 In that day shall the LORD defend the inhabitants of Jerusalem; and he that is feeble among them at that day shall be as David; and the house of David shall be as God, as the angel of the LORD before them.

Zec 12:9 And it shall come to pass in that day, that I will seek to destroy all the nations that come against Jerusalem.

*Who is being destroyed?*

Zec 9:15 The LORD of hosts shall defend them; and they shall devour, and subdue with sling stones; and they shall drink, and make a noise as through wine; and they shall be filled like bowls, and as the corners of the altar.

*Are they not devouring the wicked?*

Isa 60:19 The sun shall be no more thy light by day; neither for brightness shall the moon give light unto thee: but the LORD shall be unto thee an everlasting light, and thy God thy glory.

Isa 60:20 Thy sun shall no more go down; neither shall thy moon withdraw itself: for the LORD shall be thine everlasting light, and the days of thy mourning shall be ended.

Isa 60:21 Thy people also shall be all righteous: they shall inherit the land for ever, the branch of my planting, the work of my hands, that I may be glorified.

Isa 60:22 A little one shall become a thousand, and a small one a strong nation: I the LORD will hasten it in his time.

*Does the above not refer to after the great white throne on the new earth?*

Ezek 45:19 And the priest shall take of the blood of the **sin offering**, and put it upon the posts of the house, and upon the four corners of the settle of the altar, and upon the posts of the gate of the inner court.

*Would there be a sin offering if there were no sin?*

Ezek 44:29 They shall eat the meat offering, and the **sin offering**, and the **trespass offering**: and every dedicated thing in Israel shall be theirs.

*Why a trespass offering if no trespass?*

Rev 2:26 And he that overcometh, and keepeth my works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations:

Rev 2:27 And he shall rule them with a **rod of iron**; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of my Father.

*Why would he rule with a rod of iron if there was no sin?*

Rev 12:5 And she brought forth a man child, who was to rule all nations with a **rod of iron**: and her child was caught up unto God, and to his throne.

*Why would he rule with a rod of iron if there was no sin?*
